Benefits

UCR Email and NetID Access

Retirees who join the UCRRA are eligible to keep their UCR email and netid which includes files, folders, Google drives, online versions of Microsoft Office applications and more. Those who join after their retirement date may not have access to their files and folders so joining early is highly recommended. Emeriti who are academic senate members automatically keep their UCR email and netid access in retirement.





Free Retiree Digital Parking Permit

Active dues paying members obtain a *free* digital retiree parking permit that grants members to park on campus in the Red and Blue spaces in lots 1, 6, 13 and 24 annually.

Retiree/Emeriti R'Card

Retirees and emeriti can easily validate their status on campus with their R'Card to purchase an All Sports Pass, access the library, get a 10% discount at UCR's Bookstore.

How to Join

- 4. The system will send an automatic email to register your new account which requires you to click on the link in the email to activate your account.
